



Swiss participation in Erasmus+ cooperation projects:

International Programme (IP)

Swiss-led worldwide cooperation projects (incl. Europa)

Movetia finances up to 60% of effective costs incurred (2023):

- Personnel costs
- Mobility costs
- Other costs

International Programme 2022: Evaluation of the applications

- Relevance of the project (30%)
- Impact & results (30%)
- Quality of project design & implementation (20%)
- Project team & agreement (20%)

2023 application deadlines


- International programme: probably spring 2023





- 3. ...contributes to one or more of the programme objectives
 - → Institutional networks and peer learning
 - → Development of educational offers
 - Strengthening and further development of the quality and competitiveness of the Swiss educational system


Develop your project and work on your application



Make sure and show that:

- your project is needed
- your project builds on or complements existing offers and initiatives
- your project is likely to have an impact in the long run (sustainability)
- your projects respects the formal criteria of the funding programme

How to choose the Movetia grant?

Identify the most appropriate grant you want to apply for

Adapt the project budget to the grant chosen
